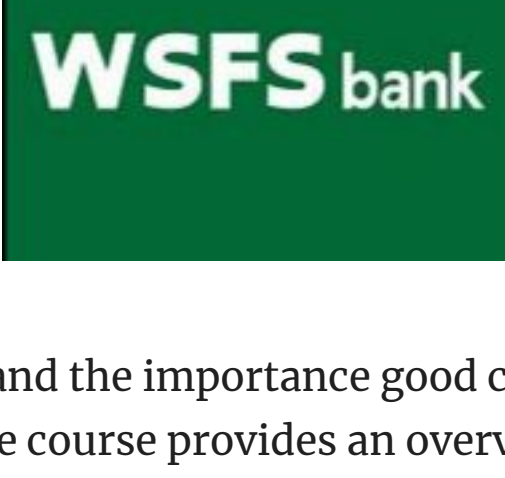

Student Spotlight: Abdel Hassouna

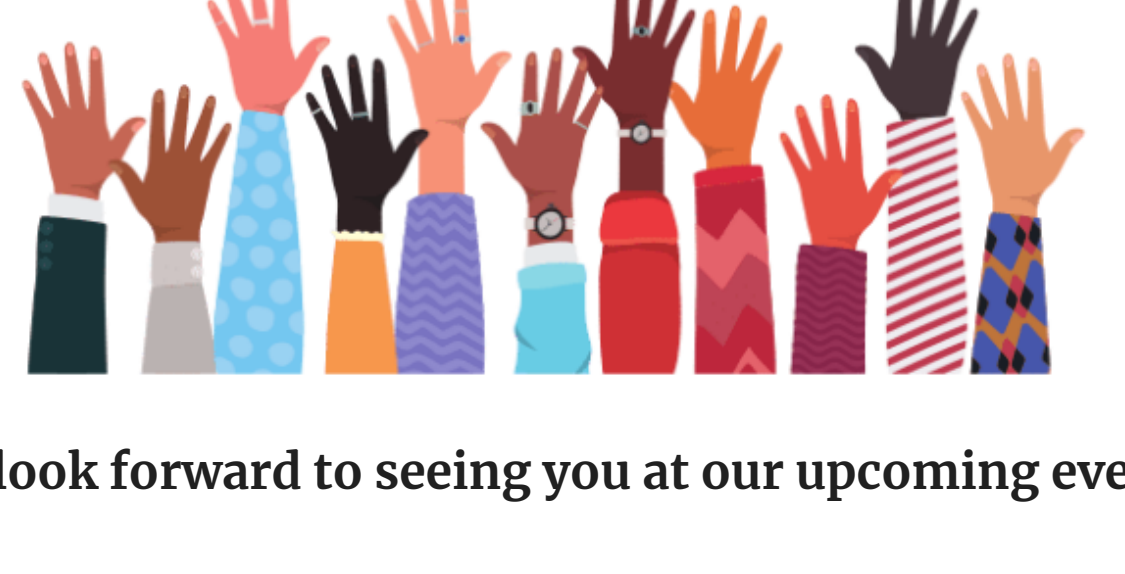


New Secretary for the CSN Consortium Chapter
